TARGET GROUPS:

Teachers (both Primary and Secondary), principals, school leaders, teacher trainers and policy makers

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

This EU project aims to enhance the capacity of non-specialist ICT teachers to provide interactive, student-centred teaching and learning. Identifying and providing the training and support delegates need to engage students' pre-existing digital skills in support of their learning, personal and social growth, vocational skills, and lifelong employability.

The course will encourage the demonstration and sharing of best practice between LOGGED-ON partners and the course participants. LOGGED-ON enabled non specialist teachers to experiment with technology in their classrooms and was led by learning, not the technology. Delegates will develop an action plan of how they can enhance learning in their own institutions, without significant investment, facilitated by the LOGGED-ON team.

Course participants will also be encouraged to exchange their own experiences with pedagogical use of ICT.
